

# Jesus' Words from the Cross about Himself Luke 23:44-49

Introduction: Darkness (noon-3pm) Judgment: Ex. 10:21; Isa. 13:10; Jer. 15:9; Ez. 30:18; Joel 2:31; Amos 5:18-20; Mic. 3:6; Nah. 1:8; Zeph. 1:14-15; Zech. 14:6

- The **A**bandonment – Matt. 27:46 And about the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, **Eli, Eli, lema sabachthani?** that is, **“My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?”**  
Psalm 22:1,3; Luke 22:42; Isa. 53:6,10; 1 Peter 2:24; Gal. 3:13; 2 Cor. 5:21
- The **A**chievement (fulfill) – John 19:28 After this, Jesus, knowing that all was now finished, said (to fulfill the Scripture), **I thirst.**  
Psalm 22:15; 69:21; Rev. 7:17
- The **A**ccomplishment – John 19:30 When Jesus had received the sour wine, he said, **It is finished**, and he bowed his head and gave up his spirit.  
*tetelestai* – paid in full  
Col. 2:14 canceling the record of debt, nailing it to the cross  
Heb. 9:26 once for all to put away sin by the sacrifice of himself
- The **A**ssurance – Luke 23:46 Then Jesus, calling out with a loud voice, said, **Father, into your hands I commit my spirit!**  
And having said this he breathed his last.  
Psalm 31:5 (Stephen in Acts 7:59)  
Death: Mark 15:37 With a loud cry, Jesus breathed his last.  
Matt. 27:50 And when Jesus has cried out again in a loud voice, he gave up his spirit.  
John 10:18 **No one takes it from me, but I lay it down of my own accord.**  
Heb. 9:14 offered himself without spot to God.  
9 a.m.-Noon, Jesus showed that God is love  
Noon-3 p.m., Jesus showed that God is holy
